Day-by-day programme

Day 1 Arrival on Sakhalin Island. Sightseeing tour of Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk.

PLEASE NOTE! Hotel check-in from 14:00 (early check-in available with a surcharge of 50% per room per night).

Day 2 Excursion: Aniva Lighthouse and an oyster lunch at Busse Lagoon (south-eastern part of Sakhalin Island)

Route: Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk – Korsakov – Ozerskoye village – Novikovo village – Cape Aniva – Busse Lagoon

PLEASE NOTE! While on board the vessel, you must observe generally accepted rules of conduct and avoid creating dangerous or threatening situations. A life jacket must be worn at all times; if you are prone to seasickness, please take a motion-sickness remedy. During excursions, treat cultural and historical monuments with care and protect the natural environment. The boat trip depends entirely on the mercy of the sea. In the event of poor weather conditions and the impossibility of putting out to sea, the boat trip will be cancelled or replaced with a road tour to Cape Evstafiya.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Aniva Lighthouse — on this route, while travelling along the sea on boats, do not forget to bring a raincoat, hat and cotton gloves.

Oyster lunch: bring along your favourite wine. Dry white wine, prosecco and brut pair well with oysters.



Day 3 Jeep tour: Cape Ptichy and Cape Velikan (south-eastern coast of Sakhalin)

Route: Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk – Okhotskoye village – Cape Ptichy and Cape Velikan – Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk

RECOMMENDATIONS: on this route it is advisable to have comfortable trainers or trekking footwear, rubber sandals for walking on the stony seabed in the water, an insect repellent, and — for those wishing to swim — swimwear and a towel; in unfavourable weather conditions do not forget to bring a raincoat and rubber boots.

Day 4 Excursion: the Amber Coast and Tikhaya Bay (north-eastern part of Sakhalin Island)

Route: the Amber Coast - the Japanese Torii gates - the crab market in Vzmorye village - Tikhaya Bay
RECOMMENDATIONS: on this route it is advisable to have comfortable trainers or trekking footwear, rubber sandals for walking on the stony seabed in the water, an insect repellent, and — for those wishing to swim — swimwear and a towel; in unfavourable weather conditions do not forget to bring a raincoat and rubber boots.



Day 5 Jeep tour: Cape Vindis and Cape Kuznetsov

Route: Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk - Nevelsk - Cape Kuznetsov

Day 6 End of the programme. Departure from Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk.
